In this session he explained the NEP through different angles and briefly given glimpses of NEP. He stressed that this is a learning centric education system instead of student/teacher centric.

- c) IIIrd session was conducted by Mr. Satish Ranade, Industry Expert, KPIT Cummins. Mr Ranade had emphasized on the need of skilled students for the industry, and he explained how this new NEP will helpful for students to be skillful to enter in the industry.
- d) IV<sup>th</sup> session was conducted by Dr.Ajay Deshmukh, Director, Center for Industrial Mathematics, Bhaskaracharya Pratisthana, Pune. He spoke on 'Faculty development'. He focused on interdisciplinary research and its need for the development of faculties. NEP demands transdisciplinary approach for research.
